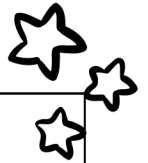

Role Overview

The volunteer coordinator plays a critical role in the overall success of Parkinson SuperWalk in their community. They will be responsible for recruiting, training and overseeing all volunteer logistics.

Monthly Commitment

4-5 hours (varies based on community and committee size).



Responsibilities

- Attends all SuperWalk committee meetings.
- Collaborates with committee members to determine the number of needed volunteers for each role.
- Manages an effective volunteer contact database, and improves upon the current records.
- Assigns volunteers their positions and tasks, ensuring to train them on any specialized duties.
- Attends and oversees all volunteer logistics on the event day.
- Provides volunteers' names to PSBC to thank them post-event.
- Participates in post-event wrap-up activities with the committee. These include the collection of receipts, committee debriefing, and other recognition activities.

The Volunteer Coordinator will be able to develop leadership, management skills, and team collaboration in a dynamic environment.

Previous experience working with volunteers is an asset.
