A Proclamation

CHARLES THE THIRD, by the Grace of God, King of Canada
and His other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Parkinson's disease, for which there are treatments but no known cure exists, is a progressive, degenerative neurological disorder that can cause tremor or trembling of the arms and legs, muscular rigidity, slowness of movement, and difficulty with speaking and swallowing, and

WHEREAS Parkinson Society British Columbia provides information, consultation, support services and educational seminars to empower and enhance the lives of people living with Parkinson's disease and their families, and

WHEREAS Parkinson's Awareness Month is an opportunity to increase the understanding of Parkinson's disease and highlight the experiences and needs of people living with this disease;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2026 shall be known as

“Parkinson's Awareness Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
